

2025 Sacramento CROP Hunger Walk Details



1. The 2024 Sacramento CROP Hunger Walk raised approx. \$8,000 of which over \$2,000 helped support our local South Sacramento Interfaith Partnership (SSIP) Food Closet, helping provide food to the food insecure in Sacramento. The remaining, and bulk of the funds, go to Church World Service (CWS), an agency that provides worldwide humanitarian aid, hunger relief, and immigrant/refugee support.
2. SSIP is one of the few Food Distribution Facilities, in Sacramento, that is open 5 days-a-week 9am-11:30am and supports an additional once per month Seniors Food distribution. Any person or family coming to the SSIP Food Closet, anywhere in the Sacramento area, will be served, however, a form of ID is required.
3. Like last year, the Walk will be by Individual(s), Church Teams, or Virtually. The Walk, in general, is requested to take place sometime between April 1st – June 31st 2025. This is so Churches, Individuals, or Virtual walkers can modify their Walk to the date that works best for all those who are involved.
4. All funds collected will again support CWS and SSIP Food Closet (25% of the total collected).
5. The easiest way to donate and collect is online using a Church's customized Sacramento Walk Website. For those desiring to donate using check or cash, please have a Church's Walk Coordinator convert the cash into a single check and then collect all other checks and turn them in to Craig Chalmers for mailing to CWS for processing. Please make sure that **all checks** are made out to **CWS/CROP Hunger Walk** with the Church name in the note line on the bottom of the check. If not affiliated with a Church, feel free to leave the note line blank.
