What is the CROP Hunger Trek?

Join fellow adventurers, justice-seekers, and CWS supporters for a once-in-a-lifetime trek through the Grand Canyon. Together, we'll mark 80 years of Church World Service with an unforgettable journey of challenge, community, and hope.

This is more than a hike. It's a pilgrimage for justice — every step you take helps end hunger and build a world where there is enough for all.

Why Trek?

- **Adventure With Purpose:** 14–17 miles across the Canyon's iconic trails.
- **Impact That Lasts:** Each participant raises \$5,000 to fight hunger and poverty through CWS.
- **Spiritual Renewal:** Trek on Palm Sunday weekend, walking in solidarity with communities worldwide.
- **Community of Leaders:** Join 10–20 committed changemakers from across the country.



What's Included?

- Transfer between airport in Phoenix and Grand Canyon
- Mini warm up hike in Sedona, AZ
- Guide Fees
- Park Fees and Parking
- Lodging at Bright Angel Lodge cabins
- Group meals

- Support every step of the way

- Experienced walkers or hikers in strong physical condition
- People who are passionate about ending hunger & poverty

The Experience

- **Mar. 27:** Fly into Phoenix. Short group hike in Sedona, then continue to Flagstaff.
- **Mar. 28:** Get supplies in Flagstaff, travel to Grand Canyon, Wine and Cheese Welcome. Overnight at the Bright Angel Lodges.
- **Mar. 29:** Trek Day! 14-17 miles descending the South Kaibab Trail, traversing the Tonto Train, optional Plateau Point spur above the Colorado River, ascending the Bright Angel Train back to the South Rim. 3,500+ feet of elevation change. Overnight at Bright Angel Lodges.
- **Mar. 30:** Drive back to Phoenix; participants fly home in late afternoon or evening.
