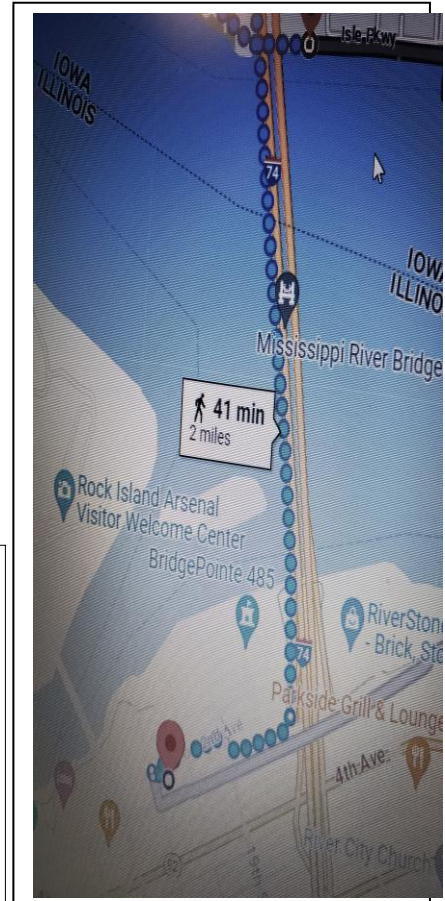
- Walk the I-74 bike & pedestrian path on Oct 4th.
