The Erie County CROP Hunger Walk is an event that brings people together who want to address the problems caused by hunger and poverty. The Walk takes place annually on the last Sunday of September. In recent years it has been held at Presque Isle State Park beginning in the Beach 1 parking lot.

Prior to the Walk – and even after – participants are encouraged to solicit sponsors from their families, friends and acquaintances. All the funds raised are used to address hunger issues locally and globally.

HOW ARE CROP WALK FUNDS DISTRIBUTED?

There are about 500 CROP Walks across the country, all of them connected to our sponsoring agency, Church World Service. The 37 member denominations of CWS pledge "to do in partnership what none of us could hope to do as well alone." That same pledge holds true for all the groups that join in the CROP Walk.
